**General Info**

At the junction of Côtes de Blaye and Côtes de Bourg wines Hope (AOC first coast de-Blaye) seem to be the perfect meeting between wines of Bourg and Blaye wines. Owners are Annie and Denis Beurier, speaking several languages! (English, Italian, Spanish).

The wines under the Bordeaux Supérieur appellation form a selection from Bordeaux wines, being subject to more stringent production and ageing conditions. They offer all the characteristics of top-quality wines, suitable for cellaring. Bordeaux Supérieur wines are full-bodied with a range of aromas and flavours which will appeal to all wine connoisseurs.

**Vineyards**

The vineyards extend over 8 hectares and the vines of Chateau l'Espérance, merlot, cabernet franc and malbec) give a beautiful ruby color, intense aromas of red fruits (cherries) and ripe fruit complemented by spicy notes, a nose almost animal. In the mouth the wine is fat and rich, full and balanced with a nice finish to round tannin.

**Maturation**

The harvest is mechanical, traditional vinification with temperature control and long maceration. The wine is in barrels with 33% new for a period of 12 months.

**Tasting Notes**

This dense wine, with a deep purple colour, offers an extraordinarily rich nose of fruit in alcohol enhanced by pleasant peppery touches. Firm and round on the palate, rich and full-bodied.

Grilled red meats, poultry and a cheese platter.
