Kettle Valley Winery is a small farm-based winery located on the Naramata Bench, Okanagan, BC. Their focus is quality and by staying a small family owned and operated winery they believe that their passion will show through in their wines. Naramata is easily the premier growing region in British Columbia, with its moderate temperatures, abundant sunshine and cooling breezes. The rolling hills and variable soil types result in growing sites with unique microclimates that can be matched to the right varieties by an experienced grape grower. No matter what style of wine you like, you will find it in Naramata. Drawing its name from the Kettle Valley Railway, which traveled through the Naramata area on the east side of Okanagan Lake, the winery opened to the public in 1996. Kettle Valley Winery is known for its dark, intense, and well-structured red wines, including Pinot Noir, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and blends such as "Old Main Red". Chardonnay has been the main white wine produced, but in recent years Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer, Semillon, and Sauvignon Blanc have also proved popular. They are all flavourful and aromatic, with a rich mouth feel.

Chardonnay 2019

Grape Variety 100% Chardonnay

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the Similkameen Valley and the Okanagan Valley and were

handpicked at approximately 23.9 brix.

Harvest The chardonnay was handpicked between October 16 to October 22, 2019.

Vinification/ The grapes were crushed and left on the skins to cold soak for two days prior to being pressed off, clarified, and inoculated with yeast. This wine was partially fermented in older French oak.

Tasting Notes This Chardonnay shows rich tropical fruit flavours of pineapple and ripe stone fruit on the

palate. Crisp acidity, medium body, and hints of vanilla. This wine has not gone through

malolactic fermentation.

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Pinot Gris 2022

Grape Variety 100% Pinot Gris

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the following vineyards: Gill in Osoyoos, Pereira in the

Similkameen Valley, and the Krebs and Cossentine vineyard in Penticton.

Harvest The grapes for this wine were handpicked between October 6 and October 13, 2022, at

approximately 24.7 brix.

Vinification/ The grapes were crushed and left on the skins to cold soak for up to three days prior to being

pressed off. A portion of this wine has been barrel fermented before being blended with wine

that was fermented in stainless steel tanks.

Tasting Notes That's right! It's a lovely pink! It's also flavourful, aromatic, and full-bodied with good structure, a

rich mouthfeel, and a spicy finish. One of the most classic BC Pinot Gris, and the one that started the trend for a pretty copper hue. This beauty of a Pinot Gris shows classic red and green apples,

pear, citrus, and tropical notes.

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the following vineyards: Gill in Osoyoos, Pereira and Secord in

the Similkameen Valley, and the Cossentine vineyard in Penticton

Harvest The grapes for this wine were handpicked between September 14 and October 12, 2020, at

approximately 24.1 brix.

Vinification/ The grapes were crushed and left on the skins to cold soak for three days prior to being pressed off.

Maturation A portion of this wine has been barrel fermented before being blended with wine that was

fermented in stainless steel tanks.

Tasting Notes That's right! It's a lovely pink! It's also flavourful, aromatic, and full-bodied with good structure, a

rich mouthfeel and a spicy finish. One of the most classic BC Pinot Gris, and the one that started the trend for a pretty copper hue. This beauty of a Pinot Gris shows classic red and green apples, pear,

citrus, and tropical notes.

Serve with Great with salmon, chicken, and other seafood dishes.

Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2016

Grape Variety 50% Semillon, 50% Sauvignon Blanc

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the King Drive and Barber vineyards in Naramata.

Harvest The grapes were handpicked on September 29, 2016, at approximately 23.6 brix.

Harvest The grapes were handpicked on September 29, 2016, at approximately 23.6 brix. **Vinification/** A portion of this wine was barrel fermented in older French oak. This is a complex blend; the

Maturation Sémillon was in oak, the Sauvignon Blanc was made in stainless steel

Tasting Notes The finished wine combines the zesty finish of the Sauvignon Blanc with the rich, full body

texture and flavours of the Semillon. This blend is fruit forward with notes of fresh tropical fruit,

minerals, honey, melon and a rich full mouthfeel.

Serve with Serve with scallops, lobster, salmon, or trout. Also great with chicken or prawns in a rich creamy

sauce; seafood risotto; or chicken satay.

Old Main Red 2020

Grape Variety Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec

Vineyards This wine is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot, grown primarily in our "Old

Main" vineyard with 5% Petit Verdot and Malbec grown in our King Drive vineyard, both located in

Naramata

Harvest The Old Main Red was harvested between October 21 and October 28, 2020. The grapes were hand-

picked at approximately 24.5 brix.

Vinification/ This wine has gone through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 21 months

Maturation before being bottled.

Tasting Notes This is a Bordeaux style wine, a big, earthy red, a complex wine with aromas of black currant, hints of

vanilla and flavours of currants, blackberries, plums, and figs finishing with soft silky tannins on the

palate.

Serve with Great with a Roast leg of lamb; a hearty steak; beef stroganoff; duck confit; fried chicken; or pork

ragout.

Production 216 cases of 750ml bottles.







Old Main Red 2017

CSPC# 553123 12x750ml 14.5% alc./vol.

Grape Variety Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec

Vineyards This grapes for this wine are grown primarily in our "Old Main" vineyard with 5% Petit Verdot and

Malbec grown in our King Drive vineyard, both located in Naramata.

Harvest The grapes were hand-picked on October 19 and October 31, 2017, at approximately 25.9 brix.

Vinification/ The wine has gone through full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 22 months

Maturation prior to bottling.

Tasting Notes The Old Main Red from Naramata producer Kettle Valley is the winery's take on a Bordeaux-style

blend, and it is a winner. The deep garnet coloured charmer is elegant on the nose and palate and

has a long, balanced finish.

Serve with Great with a Roast leg of lamb; a hearty steak; beef stroganoff; duck confit; fried chicken; or pork

ragout.

Production 350 cases of 750ml bottles

Caboose – formerly Starboard NV (Non Vintage)

Grape Variety Malbec, Petit Verdot

Vineyards The grapes for this fortified wine come primarily from our King Drive vineyard located in Naramata.

Harvest The grapes, Malbec, and Petit Verdot, were hand-picked at approximately 24 brix.

Maturation The wine was barrel aged French oak.

Tasting Notes This is Kettle Valley's take on Port, made with Petit Verdot and Malbec. It is a rich wine, tasting like

a plum pudding, with a long, elegant finish. A very good wine.

Crest Cabernet 2018 (formerly Barber Cabernet)

Grape Variety 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the Crest vineyard in Naramata.

Harvest The grapes were hand-picked on October 24, 2018, at approximately 24.2 brix.

Vinification This wine has gone through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 19

months before being bottled

Tasting Notes This one-acre block was originally planted in 1994 but the vines were pulled out and the vineyard

replanted in 2010. The vineyard is farmed using the Scott Henry training system, which is very labour intense, but results in consistent year to year ripening. The Crest Cabernet has flavours of black currant, black cherry, and hints of vanilla. Very full body, rich on the palate with smooth soft

tannins.

Serve with Beef, lamb, poultry, and spicy food.

Grape Variety Pinot Noir, Merlot, & other red wine grapes

Vineyards This wine is a blend of Pinot Noir, Merlot and selected other red varieties grown primarily in

vineyards in Naramata.

Vinification/ The wine has gone through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in American and French

Maturation oak before being blended to tank and bottled. The wine has been made in a style that allows it to

be very soft and smooth on the palate. Enjoy young. 350 cases of 750ml bottles.

Tasting Notes Light and fruity on the palate. Nose of raspberry and flowers. This was a fun red blend of merlot

and Pinot that had more depth and complexity than expected for the price. Great everyday

sipping wine that went well with two light pasta dishes.

Grape Variety 100% Pinot Noir

Vineyards This wine is a blend of select barrels of Pinot Noir grown primarily in the Brar vineyard in Kaleden

and the Hayman vineyard in Naramata and is a blend of best barrels post fermentation.

Harvest The grapes for this wine were hand-picked between October 12 and October 21, 2020at

approximately 23.3 brix.

Vinification The wine has gone through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 20

months before being bottled

Tasting Notes Bright dark red colour, medium body wine. An intriguing nose full of plum, black cherry, and

raspberry fruit leather. Bright acidity, silky tannins, bold flavours, with hints of vanilla.

Serve with Moroccan lamb and scalloped potatoes; Parmesan & Rosemary crackers (as the Parmesan

perfectly complements the black cherries, spices, and sage in the wine)

Pinot Noir 2021

Grape Variety 100% Pinot Noir

Vineyards This wine is a blend of Pinot Noir grown in the Brar vineyard in Kaleden and the Hayman vineyard

in Naramata.

Harvest The grapes were handpicked between October 2 and October 4, 2021, at approximately 24.8 brix.

Vinification/ The wine was allowed to go through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for

Maturation 12 months before being bottled.

Tasting Notes Earthy light oak and a hint of tart berries cut a swath through this otherwise earthy Pinot Noir.

Serve with Peking Duck. Roasted Beef Tenderloin. Bacon stuffed mushrooms.

Merlot 2019

Grape Variety 100% Merlot

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the King Drive and McGraw vineyards in Naramata.

Harvest The grapes were hand-picked on October 21 and October 28, 2019, at approximately 23.5 brix.

Vinification The wine has gone through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 21

months.

Tasting Notes This is a satisfying Merlot, with ripe tannins and flavours of black currants and blackberries.

Serve with Pairs well with jambalaya, barbeque, lamb, and meat sauces.

Grape Variety 100% Pinot Noir

This vineyard is one of our original plantings, in 1988, and is our home vineyard. Vineyards

Harvest The grapes were hand-picked on October 12 at approximately 24.7 brix.

This grapes for this wine come from our Hayman vineyard in Naramata. This wine has gone Vinification/ Maturation

through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 20 months before being

bottled.

This is a limited bottling of a single vineyard Pinot Noir. The wine has a rich ruby colour, **Tasting Notes**

medium body, and full mouth feel with soft silky tannins. Flavours of red cherry, ripe plums,

earthy notes, and hints of vanilla

Serve with Pair with Salmon, chicken, pork, duck, mushrooms, tomatoes, brie, and camembert.
