Little or no chemical fertilizers are used, and careful use of organic fertilizers allow the vines to reach an advanced age, they are generally pulled out (with a heavy heart) when they reach 80 years old.

The winery is in their 1st year of organic conversion.

General Info

Given the refined selection of fine wines after two decades, the Carruades feature characteristics similar to those of the fine wine, but with their own personality linked to a higher percentage of Merlot in its composition, and plots of land that are clearly identified as producing Carruades. The origin of the name comes from the Carruades plateau, the name of a group of plots adjacent to the chateau's best vineyards, purchased in 1845 by Château Lafite. In the 20th century, the Carruades were marketed separately from Château Lafite before being integrated. The name Carruades, adopted as the name of Château Lafite Rothschild's second wine, was initially called "Moulin des Carruades" before the 1980's.

Carruades is actually one of the older second wines in Bordeaux, as it was first produced in the mid-1850s. About 100 years later during the mid-1960s, the estate reintroduced its second wine naming it Moulin de Carruades. The name was changed again in the 1980s to Carruades de Lafite.

Carruades de Lafite has similar characteristics to the grand vin of Château Lafite Rothschild. Its name derives from the Carruades plateau, a group of plots that were acquired in 1845 near the vines on the Château hilltop. The wine has a softer feel, largely due to the higher percentages of Merlot. Yet make no mistake, Carruades de Lafite is a formidable Second Wine with plenty of ageing power.

It was hard to cheat in 2021 and that suited us very well as it allowed us to reveal the true face of Carruades. The blending rules we set ourselves have been refined from year to year, and this vintage required historically precise selection. Furthermore, Carruades benefitted from the Merlots from our great terroirs on the south-eastern plateau that failed to make the mark for the first wine.

The backbone of the Carruades style this year, the « complants », new plantings* from our finest plots also stood out, revealing that, even when still young, vines planted on great terroir learn quickly (we even briefly considered blending them in the first wine!). "But it's the talent for concealing that ardent youth entirely lacks; hate, love, joy, sorrow - every feeling, it blabs, and spills them in its tracks," writes Alexander Pushkin in Eugene Onegin, an accurate portrait of our young vines, whose voice came out loud and clear this year with the return of a milder vintage. Here's hoping that the aging trials we have been carrying out on Carruades for a few

years will allow us to go even further in designing this very graceful style, which definitely has nothing to hide.

Chateau Carruades de Lafite, second wine of Lafite Rothschild, is located in Pauillac. Plantings on the vineyard adjacent the chateau's best plots consist of 50 to 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30 to 50% Merlot and between 0

and 5% Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot.

Maturation Ageing for 16 to 20 months, 80% in oak barrels (10% new).



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Tasting Notes

This comes from younger vines (generally under 10 years old) from all vineyard plots of the estate, benefiting from the same fantastic, gravelly terroir as the grand vin. It is a true second wine. Concentrated black and sweet berry fruit dominates the nose, which is lifted by a hint of sweet spice from the 40% new oak, and a burst of menthol freshness. The palate is ripe and dense, with blackberries, damsons, and black cherries, and plenty of smooth, velvety tannins to finish.

Serve with

Best paired with all types of classic meat dishes, veal, pork, beef, lamb, duck, game, roast chicken, roasted, braised, and grilled dishes. Chateau Lafite Rothschild is also good when matched with Asian dishes, rich fish courses like tuna, salmon, mushrooms, and pasta.

"The 2021 Carruades de Lafite is mostly composed of the younger replacement vines dotted throughout Lafite's vineyards on the plateau, which are harvested separately. Offering up aromas of red berries, cassis, cedar box and orange rind, it's medium to full-bodied, lively, and layered, with good concentration and a long, penetrating finish. It's a blend of 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 36% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot and 5% Cabernet Franc, part of which was matured in wooden vats rather than barriques."
