Vintage Challenging conditions led to a reduced wine grape crop for South African

producers in 2016, but grapes were healthy and concentrated flavours promise good wines. The weather was very warm, especially from the end of October towards the end of January, which restricted the growth and constituted lower bunch masses and smaller berries. However, the dry conditions led to the vineyards and grapes being very healthy overall. Spring came on time and the weather conditions were ideal which led to good, even bud burst. The harvest period started a week early due to the warmer weather and it ended about two weeks

earlier.

**Vineyards** The Proprietor's Blend is a blend of six varieties that are grown on the property.

These vineyards grow on the warm, north-facing slopes of the Helderberg region within the Stellenbosch appellation. These particular varieties thrive under these conditions and result in rich, full-bodied red wines. With an altitude of approximately 250 metres above sea level, together with the cooling influence of the Atlantic Ocean, the ripening period can be extended, resulting in wines with

phenolic ripeness.

**Harvest** The grapes are hand-harvesting in the cool of the early morning.

**Maturation** Whole berries are fermented in open top tanks and barrels with intermittent

pump-overs and punch-downs to ensure a balance between flavour, colour and tannin extraction from the skins. All ferments are meticulously monitored to ensure that all the natural aromas and flavours are preserved. After primary fermentation, some tanks will undergo extended maceration. Each variety is matured separately in oak before final blending. Aged for 18 months. 95% in 300 litre French Oak

barrels (35% new) and 5% in 300 litre American Oak barrels (30% new)

American and French oak is finely woven into the long finish, providing layers for

further of aging potential over 10 years.

**Tasting Notes** 

The Proprietor's Blend is once again impressive and serious in 2016. Medium to full-bodied, it is strewn with black fruits, exotic spice and shards of dark chocolate. Sweet, spicy oak melts into a dense, powerfully fruited and structured core. The majority Cabernet Sauvignon gives a cassis purity and salty edge, while the Shiraz component adds a meaty, savoury and spicy edge. The blend is rounded off by the remaining Bordeaux cultivars in a complexity explosion from start to finish. It is exquisitely textured and finely tuned. The 2016 will open up over the next 5 years and age for a decade or more.
