General Info Château Devise D'Ardilley was created in 1991. It has modern winemaking facilities and

vine plots which have gradually been grouped together and replanted. The estate was bought in 2000 by Madeleine and Jacques Philippe, realising a personal dream. Born in the Bordeaux area, Madeleine wanted to return to her roots, while Philippe, a qualified engineer having pursued a career with a major services company, wanted to become a winegrower. Their dream became a reality and the wine obtained Cru Bourgeois status in

the 2003 classification.

Vineyards The vineyard is situated on a hilly terrain of gravely soil with underlying calcareous clay.

The vines are farmed by traditional means with yield control (leaf and bunch thinning). The vine plots are kept meticulously, the owner putting every effort into obtaining healthy, ripe grapes. 45% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot. Average

vine age is 23 - 24 years

Harvest Harvesting is both by hand and by machine (50 percent each) and the grapes are sorted

at the winery.

Vinification/ Vinification takes place under temperature control, with alcoholic and malolactic **Maturation** fermentation conducted in the traditional way but with the addition of some new

techniques - cold maceration, concentration by means of reverse osmosis and micro-oxygenation. The wine is aged exclusively in French oak, one-third of the volume in new

barrels, for one year.

Tasting Notes It is of ruby red colour. The bouquet is extremely refined, with notes of blackberry, spice,

smoke and faded rose. Its texture shows suave and velvety, with a pleasant balance and

no over extraction, stylish well balanced and gorgeous.
