Kettle Valley Winery is a small farm-based winery located on the Naramata Bench, Okanagan, BC. Their focus is quality and by staying a small family owned and operated winery they believe that their passion will show through in their wines. Naramata is easily the premier growing region in British Columbia, with its moderate temperatures, abundant sunshine, and cooling breezes. The rolling hills and variable soil types result in growing sites with unique microclimates that can be matched to the right varieties by an experienced grape grower. No matter what style of wine you like, you will find it in Naramata. Drawing its name from the Kettle Valley Railway, which traveled through the Naramata area on the east side of Okanagan Lake, the winery opened to the public in 1996. Kettle Valley Winery is known for its dark, intense, and well-structured red wines, including Pinot Noir, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and blends such as "Old Main Red". Chardonnay has been the main white wine produced, but in recent years Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer, Semillon, and Sauvignon Blanc have also proved popular. They are all flavourful and aromatic, with a rich mouth feel. The winemakers are Bob Ferguson & Tim Watts

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the following vineyards: Gill in Osoyoos, Pereira and Secord in

the Similkameen Valley, and the Cossentine vineyard in Penticton

The grapes for this wine were handpicked between September 14 and October 12, 2020, at Harvest

approximately 24.1 brix.

Vinification/ The grapes were crushed and left on the skins to cold soak for three days prior to being pressed off.

Maturation A portion of this wine has been barrel fermented before being blended with wine that was

fermented in stainless steel tanks.

Tasting Notes That's right! It's a lovely pink! It's also flavourful, aromatic, and full-bodied with good structure, a

> rich mouthfeel and a spicy finish. One of the most classic BC Pinot Gris, and the one that started the trend for a pretty copper hue. This beauty of a Pinot Gris shows classic red and green apples, pear,

citrus, and tropical notes.

Serve with Drink this when you eat any white fish or salmon. Other pairing suggestions include Avocado and

Papaya Salad; Balsamic Grilled Radicchio with Shaved Pecorino; Basic Basil Pesto; and Zucchini and

Red Onion Frittata alla Pisa.

Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2016

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the King Drive and Barber vineyards in Naramata.

The grapes were handpicked on September 29, 2016, at approximately 23.6 brix. Harvest

Vinification/ A portion of this wine was barrel fermented in older French oak. This is a complex blend; the

Maturation Sémillon was in oak, the Sauvignon Blanc was made in stainless steel

Tasting Notes The finished wine combines the zesty finish of the Sauvignon Blanc with the rich, full body

texture and flavours of the Semillon. This blend is fruit forward with notes of fresh tropical fruit,

minerals, honey, melon and a rich full mouthfeel.

Serve with Serve with scallops, lobster, salmon, or trout. Also great with chicken or prawns in a rich creamy

sauce; seafood risotto; or chicken satay.







Chardonnay 2019

Grape Variety 100% Chardonnay

Vineyards The grapes for this wine come from the Similkameen Valley and the Okanagan Valley and were

handpicked at approximately 23.9 brix.

Harvest The chardonnay was harvested between October 16 to October 22, 2019.

Winemaking This wine was partially fermented in older French oak.

Tasting Notes This Chardonnay shows rich tropical fruit flavours of pineapple and ripe stone fruit on the palate.

Crisp acidity, medium body, and hints of vanilla. This wine has not gone through malolactic

fermentation. 890 cases made.

Caboose – formerly Starboard NV (Non Vintage)

Grape Variety Malbec, Petit Verdot

Vineyards The grapes for this fortified wine come primarily from our King Drive vineyard located in Naramata.

Harvest The grapes, Malbec, and Petit Verdot, were hand-picked at approximately 24 brix.

Maturation The wine was barrel aged French oak.

Tasting Notes This is Kettle Valley's take on Port, made with Petit Verdot and Malbec. It is a rich wine, tasting like

a plum pudding, with a long, elegant finish. A very good wine.

Grape Variety Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec

Vineyards This wine is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot, grown primarily in our

"Old Main" vineyard with 5% Petit Verdot and Malbec grown in our King Drive vineyard, both

located in Naramata

Harvest The Old Main Red was harvested between October 21 and October 28, 2019. The grapes were

hand-picked at approximately 24.5 brix.

Winemaking Full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 21 months before being bottled.

Tasting Notes This is a Bordeaux style wine, a big, earthy red, a complex wine with aromas of black currant, hints

of vanilla and flavours of currants, blackberries, plums, and figs finishing with soft silky tannins on

the palate. 216 cases of 750ml bottles.

Serve with Great with a Roast leg of lamb; a hearty steak; beef stroganoff; duck confit; fried chicken; or pork

ragout.
