**Harvest** The grapes were hand-picked on October 12 at approximately 24.7 brix.

**Vinification/  
Maturation** This grapes for this wine come from our Hayman vineyard in Naramata. This wine has gone through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 20 months before being bottled.

**Tasting Notes** This is a limited bottling of a single vineyard Pinot Noir. The wine has a rich ruby colour, medium body, and full mouth feel with soft silky tannins. Flavours of red cherry, ripe plums, earthy notes, and hints of vanilla

<b>Vinification/ Maturation</b>	The wine has gone through a full malolactic fermentation and was aged in French oak for 22 months before being bottled. This is a limited bottling of a single vineyard Pinot Noir.
<b>Tasting Notes</b>	Nose of slightly jammy strawberry which settled down to give way to more subtle licorice, cloves, a little bit of mocha, and floral notes. Super rich, thick mouthfeel and loads of concentrated fruit. Almost too much to be varietally appropriate for pinot, but saved by fine tannins and just enough acidity to keep things light on the feet. Very pleasant finish.

<b>Winemakers</b>	Bob Ferguson & Tim Watts
<b>Vineyards</b>	The grapes for this wine come from the Beichman vineyard, King Drive vineyard and Old Main vineyard, all in Naramata.
<b>Harvest</b>	The grapes were hand-picked between October 13 and November 7, 2006 at approximately 25.7 brix.
<b>Vinification/ Maturation</b>	The wine was aged in French oak for 21 months before bottling. Total production 150 cases.
<b>Tasting Notes</b>	The wine begins with a hit of white pepper on the nose. It is a concentrated red with earthy flavours of plum and black cherry. Med deep ruby/ cherry red - peppery, herbal nose - lovely red and black berry palate - delish and fruity w some oak and spice backing it up - exc acidity supports alc. - seems med bodied, not OTT, which might be expected at 15.40% alc. A bit simple but very tasty.
<b>Production</b>	Total production 150 cases of 750ml bottles.
