Tasting Notes Our 2008 Kettle Valley Malbec has wonderful soft notes of blueberry. I find that BC

Malbec consistently show notes of blueberry and this is not found in Malbecs from other areas. The hot days combined with colder night time temperatures in the Okanagan

really allows the fruit flavors to develop and stand out.
