Vintage	2020 begins with a mild and wet winter and a spring with lots of rain. The vines therefore begin to bud early. At Château Monbousquet, the vintage is therefore early. The summer is hot and dry which allows the grapes to reach a very good maturity quickly.
Vineyards	The surface area of Château Monbousquet is 32 hectares. Concerning white wine, the castle devotes 1 hectare to its production. There is 65% Sauvignon Blanc, 30% Sauvignon Gris and 5% Sémillon and Muscadelle blended. The soils are very rich with deep gravel and sandy clay soils.
Harvest	The harvest is carried out manually then sorted. The pressing is then carried out on the whole bunches. Pruned to six spurs, leaf thinning, and green harvesting. The grapes are picked and sorted by hand.
Vinification/ Maturation	The white wine of Château Monbousquet benefits from aging for six months in 25% vats, 38% new oak barrels and 37% one-year-old barrels The final blending is done just before bottling, and the wine is neither fined nor filtered.
Tasting Notes	This wine is very pleasant on the nose. It is fruity with notes of white fruits, especially white peach, and citrus. It is quite complex and aromatic. This white Monbousquet 2020 is pleasant in the mouth with a round and fat side.
