





"The key word on the label is 'Carneros,' Napa Valley home to 400 relatively cool acres air-conditioned by



the San Pablo Bay, the cabernet is planted to steep south, southwestern facing hillsides, in essence the warmest of the cool sites. The vineyards are mix of ages from 16 to 38-years old and the mix contains bits of cabernet franc (11), petit verdot (1), and malbec (1). Look for a spicy, almost peppery mix of cool red and black fruit flavours. The palate is similar with spicy, cool cedar, vanilla, balsamic notes and a fresh finish. A cool style Napa cabernet more reminiscent of the Okanagan than Napa Valley. Best now with grilled meats or let this age for six to eight years.
